**Swimming Sports:** Twelve students attended the AWD swimming sports. Results will be available later.

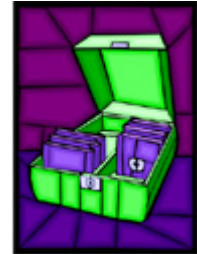
